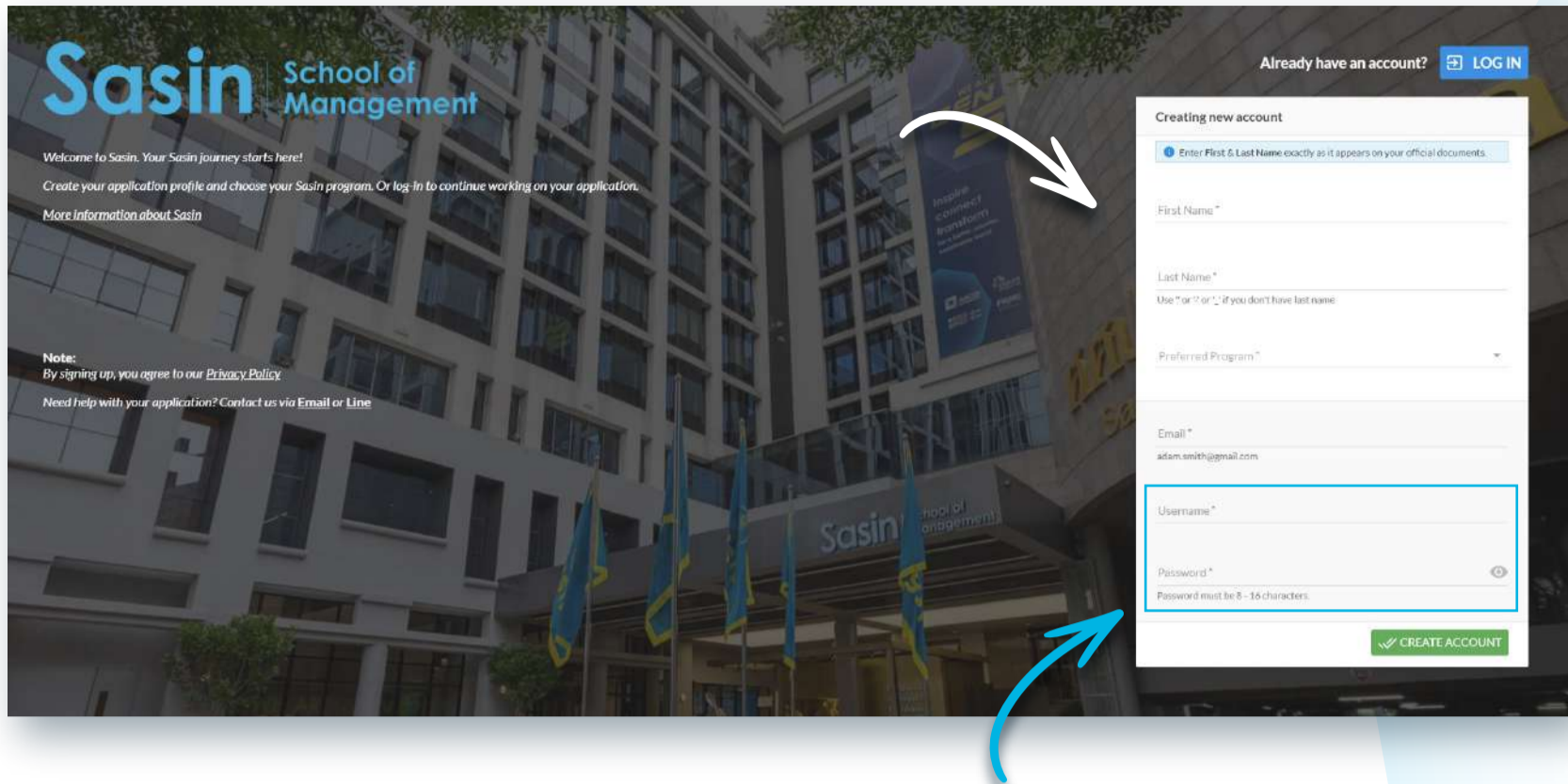


Sasin Application Guide

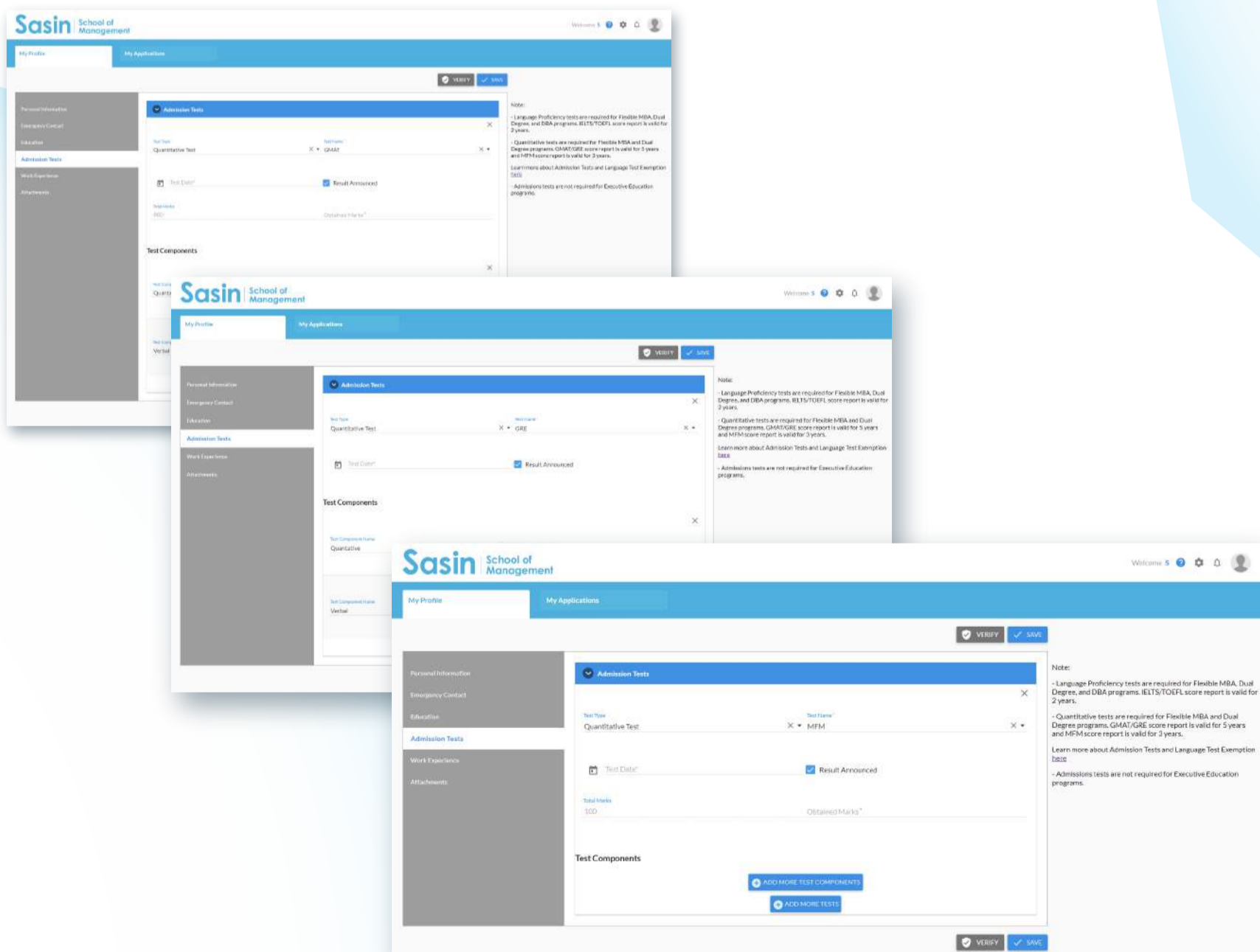

Please note that even though you have already had an interview with the committee, we cannot make a final admissions decision until we have received all supporting documents including your admission test scores.

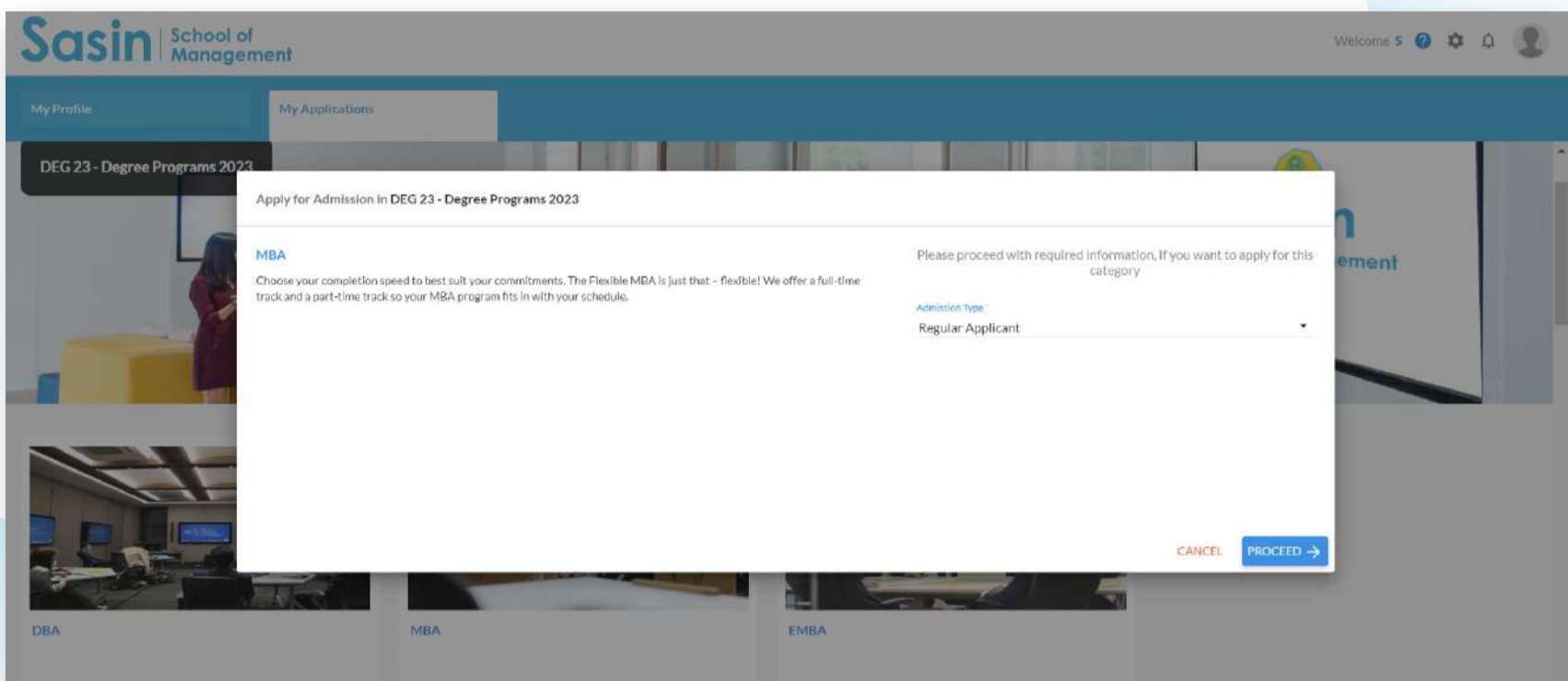
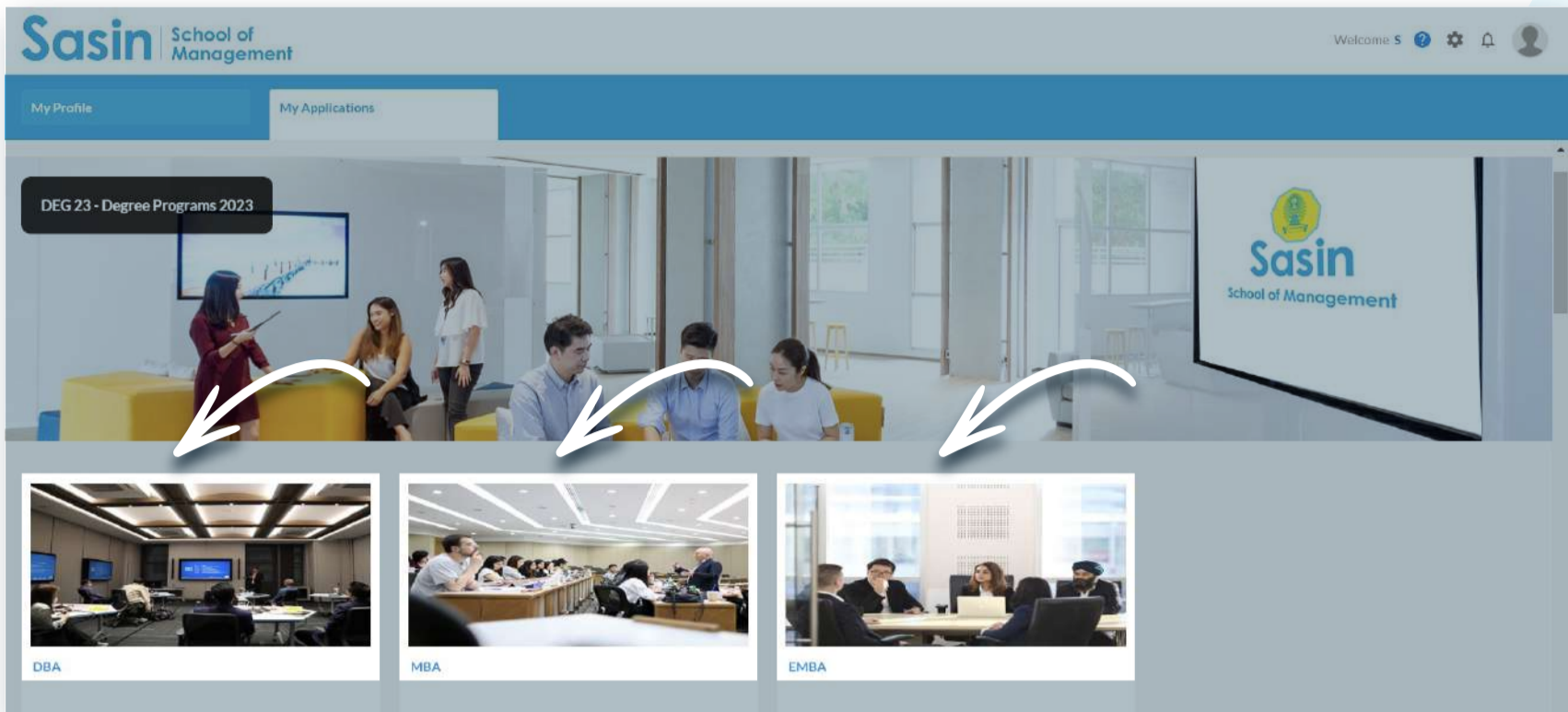




Short Essays

There will be 4 questions in this section.

The first question is about your main interests and activities outside of work and education.

Basically, we would like to know you more! Give specific examples of activities you have undertaken and what you love about them.

Questions 2-4, will be about your experience and thoughts about Ethical Social Responsibility, Entrepreneurial Mindset, and Inclusion.

We know that no organization can maintain sustainable growth without ensuring that every member feels welcomed, safe, and appreciated. We value the diverse traits, backgrounds, perspectives, and stories that our members bring, and are committed to maintaining a climate of inclusion and respect for all. We are proud to welcome individuals of all race/ethnicity/nationality origins, genders, ages, sexual orientations, socio-economic backgrounds, physical abilities, religions, and other differences that bring uniqueness to the School. Why do you think that inclusion is so often neglected by organizations as an essential sustainable business practice? (max: 150 words)
